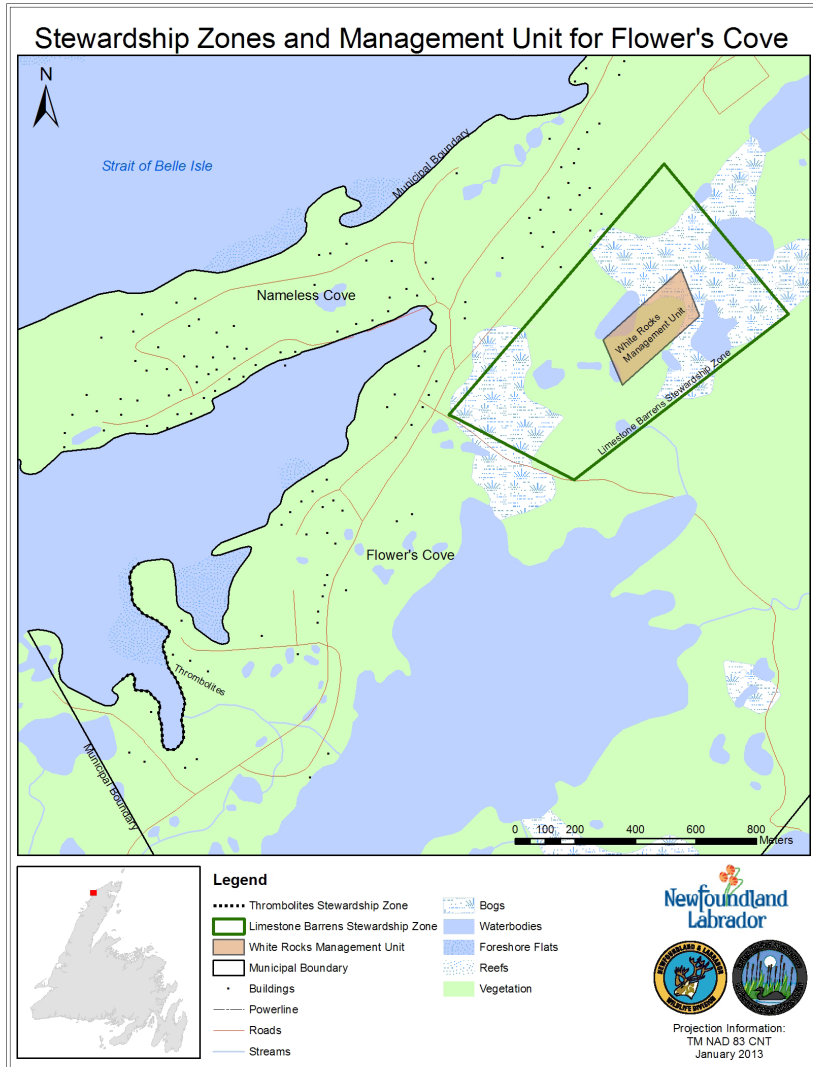


Flower's Cove Species at Risk Stewardship Agreement

The Town of Flower's Cove and the Government of Newfoundland and Labrador signed a **SPECIES AT RISK STEWARDSHIP AGREEMENT** in October 2002, committing to the conservation and enhancement of wildlife habitat within the town's planning boundaries.

The Flower's Cove Stewardship Zone contains the limestone barren habitat areas located within the municipal border. Four Management Units cover 21.44 acres, and include the White Rock management unit, the limestone barrens zone and the Thrombolites management unit.
